



“Monvoisin” is the story of a well-bred French painter down on his luck in the middle of his life, who in 1843 flees his motherland to the Antipodes in the hunt for recognition and wealth.

Settled in Santiago and Valparaiso, he struggles against an extremely conservative society in need of self identity. After almost two decades in America and 300 portraits, he returns to his remembered but changed France to settle some scores, accompanied by his devoted assistant, Clara Filleul (Lucy Cominetti), and brings along recognition and wealth.
